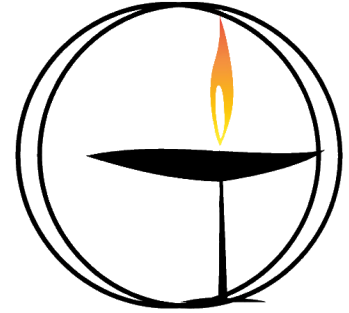

3. In case of inclement weather a roofed deck area will be used.
4. All tables must be completely set up before start time on the date of the event. Tables are not to be broken down prior to the close of the event.
5. No pets allowed.
6. Personal items must be kept under tables. Display racks and tables shall be kept neat. Table clothes/table skirts are encouraged.
7. To avoid a flea market atmosphere, we request that craft vendors refrain from "mark-downs" sale items.
8. Children must be supervised properly.
9. You must sign in with the Craft Show committee prior to setting up.
10. The craft show committee reserves the right to remove any displays that are of an offensive nature.
11. Every vendor is responsible for a thorough cleanup of their area. Please dispose of trash properly in the containers marked for recycling. Take down all displays and remove all empty boxes and bags.
